For Posterity's Sake

The Royal Canadian Naval Reserve (Special Section) Fishermen's Reserve was formed in the spring of 1938. The difficulty with creating a list of Fishermen's Reserve Vessels is what are the criteria?

I selected two criteria:

1. The first criterion - must have been part of the Fishermen's Reserve prior to the outbreak of the war.

This criterion came from a letter from the Judge Advocate-General to COPC Esquimalt, BC dated 21 Nov 1940

"To form part of the Fishermen's Reserve the vessel must have been part of the Fishermen's Reserve prior to the outbreak of the war. A Vessel being manned by personnel who belong to the Fishermen's Reserve does not mean that the vessel itself belongs to the Fishermen's Reserve."¹

2. The second criterion - must have been part of the Fishermen's Reserve Fleet controlled by CAPT D Esquimalt.

This is the accepted definition of a Fishermen's Reserve Vessel. To satisfy this criterion the vessel must have been assigned a FY number, be armed and be assigned to CAPT D Esquimalt

The Judge Advocate-General went on to say ...The mere fact that vessels are not considered to be part of the Fishermen's Reserve for the purposes of payment of Charter hire, etc., will still permit you to treat them as being Fishermen's Reserve vessels, if you so desire.¹
