EXTRACT FROM THE KING'S REGULATIONS.

Classification and Relative Rank of Officers.

The Officers of His Majesty's Navy are classified and take rank with each other as indicated in the table hereunder.

*Commissions or Warrants, as the case may be, are issued to officers on promotion to the ranks indicated, and also to commissioned officers from warrant rank on promotion to Lieutenant's rank.

All Executive Officers of the same denomination shall rank and command according to the Order in which their names stand in the official list of the officers of the Royal Navy, or, when not inserted in the list, according to the dates of their first commissions, warrants or orders in their existing rank. If only acting in the rank they shall rank and command after officers holding the corresponding confirmed rank.

and in relation to each other shall rank and command according to the order in which their names stand in the official list of the officers of the Royal Navy, unless the Admiralty may otherwise direct. Officers, other than Executive Officers, shall rank with each other and with Executive officers according to rank and seniority. Officers of the Royal Canadian Navy, Royal Australian Navy and the New Zealand Division shall rank and command with officers of the Royal Navy according to their rank and seniority in the Dominion Naval Forces.

Relative Rank of the Officers of the Navy, Army and Air Force.

Officers of the Royal Canadian Navy shall take relative rank with each other, rank for rank, according to seniority; or in the case of Commodores, date of appointment. Their relative rank with officers of the Army and Air Force, shall be as laid down in the following table and shall take effect in the same manner, according to seniority or date of appointment.
