Dear

With the proclamation of the Canadian Forces Reorganization Act 1 February 1968, the Royal Canadian Naval Reserve Active and Inactive Lists ceased to exist.

Officers formerly on the RCNR Active List are now in the Primary Reserve and officers on the Inactive List are on the Supplementary List.

As you are no doubt aware every attempt is being made to maintain a Reserve Force capable in all respects of meeting an emergency. In order to achieve this aim, and to keep the strength of the Supplementary List within practical limits, it has become necessary to limit the numbers in the Reserve Force to personnel who have not reached compulsory release age for their rank.

Regulations have now been promulgated which establish the compulsory release age for Supplementary List personnel as five years above the appropriate Regular Force release age, or the age at which ten years of unpaid service in the Reserve Force is completed.

In view of this regulation, it is with regret that you must now be informed that it is necessary to effect your release from the Reserve Force and that you will be "Honourably Released" in accordance with the Queen's Regulations and Orders, Article 15.01 Item 5(a) (Compulsory Release Age) effective 1 April 1968.

As your service is in excess of ten years you are entitled to have your name entered on the Retired List and the privilege of using the title of your rank with the word (Retired) or the appropriate abbreviation immediately following your name. Unless you advise Canadian Forces Headquarters to the contrary, it will be assumed that this is your wish and your name will be placed on the Retired List.

This occasion provides an appropriate opportunity to thank you most sincerely for your contribution as a member of the Naval Reserve over the past years. You may be justifiably proud of your service in the interest of your country.

In closing it is hoped that not only have you found your service in the Reserve Force rewarding but also that it has provided you with many pleasant memories. May you enjoy the best of health and good fortune in the future.
