"ALWAYS READ THE DAILY MEMORANDUM"

DUTY WATCH:

"Stauacona" is organized on the Four Match System. Natches are from 1300 to 1300 the following cay; but dinner ralley party start early at 1115 instead of 1300.

Duty vatch men on su sistence allowance may draw be ding from the clothing store between 1730 - 2000, returning same by 0745 the following orming. They will sleep in Dornitory 71, upper floor "J" Block.

The det Canteen is out of bounds to Duty datch. Duty latch falls in, inside the Administration Building, lirst floor, dest end.

LEAVE:

rive different types of leave are cranted.

1. Shore Leave: Ch's & PO's 1615 to 0745 1630 to 0745 Lag. Seamen 1630 to 0730 Able . Ord. Smn. 1630 to 0100 Hen: under 20

2. Weekend Leave: Begins immediately after divisions Friday expiring at the ordinary time of shore leave Monday.

3. Lower Deck Leave: The Watch on Weekend Leave may live in the Barracks but must follow out the routine outlined below -

0700 to 0805 - May carry on achore '0900 - Guard & Steerage (Dormitories to be cleaned by 1000) 1000 - May carry on ashore.

4. Long Leave: Leave not exceeding 30 days is rranted annually, if the exigencies of the service permit.

5. Compassionate Leave:

Compassionate Leave may be granted:a) for death or serious illness of a near

relative:

b) urgent private affairs.

All men must understand that they can expect sympathetic treatment from their Divisional Officer or he Officer-of-the-watch should their private affairs get out of hand in any way. Compassionate leave may be grented for a period of:

a) 14 days or less by the Cormocore; b) Not more than 30 days by Canflaglant;

c) Not more than 91 days by Chief of Naval Staff, Ottawa.

All compessionate leave is deducted from any annual leave due.

GENERAL REGULATIONS CONCERNING LEAVE:

1. All men proceed on leave and return on board via the Main Jate.

2. The Main Gate is closed at 2300 to outroing liberty : en and after 0100 returning libertymen are only a imit ou upon request to the late Sentry.

3. Men on leave who wish to r turn on board to use the Wet wanteen must enter by the Main Jate where they leave their Station Card. Men below the rate of Petty Of ther must met inn on stone from the Met Canteen ov 2300

- c) Trainers and instructors while under instruction in workshops.
- 2. All hands are permitted to wear civilian clothes while proceeding on or returning from leave.

3. Men astore may attend the "Stacacona" Augitorium Moving Pictures in civilian clothes.

- 4. Civilian Clothes may be kept on board, but must not interfere with proper stowa e of uniform clothing. Civilian Clothes must be of a reasonable standard of aress. Sports jackets or suit coats must always be worn, sweaters and windbreakers are not permitted. All civilian clothing must be rarked with owner's name in the same manner as service clothing and . ear.
- 5. Naval Identity Cards must be carried at all tires. 6. The wearing of civilian clothes does not renuer any man immune from inquiry by Shore Patrol for improper dress or improper conduct.
- 7. Only burberries and uniform shoes may be worn as a part of civilian dress.
- 8, Men on subsistence allowance are not permitted to proceed to an. from work in civilian clothes.
- 9. Men arriving on board in civilian clothes must return early enough to permit them to be changed into dress of the day ready for divisions or whatever their first duty may be.

- 5. Identification Cards (I.D.Cards): I.D. Carcs are to be carried at all times by men in uniform, or in civilian dress; while on cuty or on leave. They are only to be displayed to authorized persons.
- 6. Station Cards:

Men are to carry Station Cards at all times excert when they are on leave.



ECHRATION IN H.M.C.S. "STADACONA": -

1. Canteons -

Canteens are to be found in the Administration Building, Gymnasium, Gunnery and TAS Bldgs., Hospital and Electrical and Communications Schools. Each canteen has its own hours of business. All canteens are out of bounds during working hours.

2. Men's Wet Canteen: (Hours 1830 - 2130 daily)

a) Beer is to be consumed in the canteen and is never to be taken outside.

b) The canteen is out of bounds for men under punishment, isolation or quarantine or members of Duty Watch;

c) No civilian or barrack's employee is permitted in the Met Cantsen.

d) The Canteen is cleared at 2200.

3. Gymnasium:

Complete facilities and equipment are available for basketball, volleyball, badminton, track, squash, weight lifting, bosing and gymnastics. (Bowling 10% a game or 3 for 25%).

4. Swimming Pool:

Times of Swim Periods are to be found in the Daily Memorandum or on the Gymmasium notice board. Swim suits are available from the equipment room.

5. Moving Pictures -

Moving pictures are shown on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday nights during summer months and every night except Saturday during winter months in the TAS Building Auditorium (top floor). Admission: 10¢ each for men and lady guests.

6. Library: (Fours Mon. to Fri. 1600 - 2100)

The library is on the first floor of the Administration Building. Each man may borrow as many as six books for a period not exceeding 14 Jays.

7. Boats:

Men may go sailing by requesting permission of the Boat Officer (the Officer-in-Charge of the Seamanship Training School). The Coxswain of the boat must be of Leading Rate or above.

"Stadacona" Roats are kept in the North Camber of #5 Jetty, while sails and year are stowed in the basement of the Damage Control School.

Boats are to be back by sunset.

8. Soda Bar:

The Soda Bar in the Gymnasium is open daily from 1630 to 2200 and on Saturdays and Sundays from 1400 to 2200. Guests may be entertained in the bar after 1800. Dancing to the juke-box is permitted,

RULES RELATING TO VISITORS IN GENERAL:

1. All men from other ships wishing to use the facilities of the Bar acks (Met Canteen, Jymnasium etc) must en er by the Main Tate and must deposit their Station Cerd with the Officer of the Match.

- Men may bring guests into "Stadacona" to the moving pictures, the symnasium and the Soda Bar. All guests are to be out of "Sta:acona" by 2215.
- Men are to sign their ruests in and out of the fuest Book at the Guard House. Each man is responsible for the conduct of his guest.

THE LIQUOR LAWS OF LOVA SCOTIA:

If thin Nova Acotta the sale of liquor, including be r and wines is confine, exclusively to the Towerment Liquor Scores, and it must be purchased under a jertit with the exception of beer purchased in taverns.

Permits must be applied for on the proper forms at the Liquor Stores. The fee for a temporary 30 day permit is 25g and a yearly resident's permit is 50g. Permits are issued only to persons 21 years of are or over.

Liquor lensily purchased under the Liquor Control Act may be conveyed from one residence to another, or from any other place where the same has been lewfully purchased, provided nowever, that no liquor shall be opened or consumed while being so carried or conveyed.

Liquor may be consumed in private residences or in a hotel room where the purchaser is a bona fide guest, but must not be crought on board any of H.M.C. Ships or Establishments.
