

That the complete Crown owned establishment at Sydney, N.S., consisting of land and buildings and formerly known as Naval Service Station, Westmount, Sydney, N.S., are surplus to the requirements of the Crown;

That the cost of the said land comprising an area of 21.59 acres more or less was \$874.90; the cost of the buildings, \$16,549.89; grading, \$1140.00, and cables, \$119.78, making a total cost of \$18,684.57;

That War Assets Corporation reports having received an appraisal from their Nova Scotia appraiser, Mr. Angus Gladwin, valuing the land and buildings at \$5,600.00;

That War Assets Corporation reports that as a result of advertising in the newspapers of Sydney, North Sydney and Glace Bay, several offers were received, the highest being \$4,100.00;

That War Assets Corporation reports that an offer was made on behalf of The Director, Veterans' Land Act, to meet any offer which might be received as a result of the advertising;

That War Assets Corporation, subject to the approval of Your Excellency in Council, has negotiated the sale of the said land and buildings for \$4,100.00 to the Director, Veterans' Land Act; and

That War Assets Corporation considers the sale of the said land and buildings referred to above to be in the public interest and the price fair and reasonable.

The Committee, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Reconstruction and Supply, advise that Your Excellency may be pleased to approve the sale of the said land and buildings to The Director, Veterans' Land Act, as aforesaid; Letters Patent conveying the Crown's right, title and interest in and to the said land to issue accordingly.

It is desired that you ascertain from Mr. MacLennan and report whether he is prepared to make use of the whole area for pasture and, if not, what portion he requires.

You might indicate also whether the whole area or the portion he requires is fenced, and forward to N.S.H.Q. your recommendations in the matter in detail. If you can ascertain the rental which he may be willing to pay and the usual rate of rental in the vicinity for such pasturage such information, also would be useful to N.S.H.Q.
