Dear Mrs. Maguire:

It is with deepest regret that I must confirm the telegram of the 16th of June, 1944, from the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services, informing you that your son, John Wesley Maguire, Leading Stoker, Official Number 40911, Royal Canadian Navy, is missing from H.M.C.S. "ATHABASKAN".

Since you were informed by the Commanding Officer of H.M.C.S. "MONSUCH" that your son was not onboard H.M.C.S. "ATHABASKAN", a very thorough investigation was again made, and it has now been established that he was onboard the ill-fated ship and must be considered as missing. This information was received in a report from overseas simultaneously to receiving your letter of the 5th of June, 1944.

As it is understood that a number of the crew of H.M.C.S. "ATHABASKAN" have been taken prisoners of war by the enemy, there is a possibility of your son's survival. Every effort is being made to obtain, as soon as possible, a list of those taken. Please be assured that when any further information has been received, you will be informed immediately.

Although you have probably learned at this late date from the newspaper accounts, particulars of the sinking of your son's ship, the following details are forwarded for your information. H.M.C.S. "ATHABASKAN" was torpedoed and sunk by enemy action in the English Channel on the 29th of April, 1944. At the present time fifteen Officers and one hundred and ninety-six Royal Canadian Naval ratings are reported as missing. There were also a number of survivors landed in the United Kingdom.

Please allow me to express the sincere sympathy of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services, the Chief of the Naval Staff, and the Officers and men of the Royal Canadian Navy, the high traditions of which your son has helped to maintain.

Dear Mrs. Maguire:

I must regretfully inform you that since your son was reported missing no further information has been received of his surviv 1 or that he is a prisoner of war.

I wish to assure you, however, that the Department makes every endeavour to discover the fate of missing men and draws upon all likely sources of information about them.

In the case of men who are believed to be prisoners of war continuous efforts are made to speed up the machinery whereby their names and camp addresses can reach this country. The official means is by lists of names prepared by the enemy government. These lists take some time to compile, especially if there is a long journey from the place of capture to a prisoners of war camp. Consequently "capture cards", filled in by the prisoners themselves soon after capture and sent home to their relatives, are often the first news received in this country that a man is a prisoner of war.

Very slight hope is now held, however, that your son is a prisoner of war as the total number of names of men who are known to be prisoners from H.M.C.S. "ATHABASKAN" coincides with the number which the Germans claim to have captured from this ship.

Even if no news is received that a missing man is a prisoner of war, endeavours to trace him do not cease. Enquiries are pursued, not only among those who were serving with him, but also through diplomatic channels and the International Red Gross Committee at Ceneva. The moment reliable news is obtained from any of these sources it is sent to the Department and is immediately passed on to the next of kin.

Should no information be received to the contrary your son will be presumed dead by the Canadian Naval Authorities at a later date.
