

"Alberni" and I know there is nothing I can say that will help you in your great loss. I just wanted you to know that you have my sincerest sympathy. Your son was an excellent man both reliable and efficient. It was he that was mostly responsible for shooting down the enemy plane a few weeks ago. I have recommended him for an award for his good work. He was very well liked by all the officers and men and appeared to be very happy aboard. The only minor comfort I can give you is that he was down below at the time the ship was hit and as the ship sank instantly I am sure he did not suffer any pain. I hope that if I am ever in Saskatoon you will gite me the pleasure of allowing me to call on you. If there is any way in which I can help you, do not hesitate to write me. 

1. With reference to the eactionally noted and the memorandum of S/Insp. R.S. Persison dated the 22nd. ult., enquiries were made in Listowel and it was learned that the subject was employed with the Listowel Casket Factory.

Subject was interviewed by the writer. From his Registration of Birth Certificate it was learned that he was born in Vanda, Sask., on Sept. Sth. 1921, and that his parents were not married. His father, Anton Jacob KONDEL, is totally unknown to subject, as he has no idea where he is living or his mationality but believes him to be of Ekrainian Sationality born in Austro-Hungary. His knowledge of his mother, Belen Hownel, is slightly greater. She was born in Canada of Ekrainian descent. At the present she resides in Saskatoon, Sask., - exact address not known.

- 3. Subject went to Listowel six months ago from Blucher, Sask., where he had been residing for the past eight years.
- 4. His Estimal Registration Certificate was examined and the following details obtained: 203 Rosthern 57 Blucher Issued on Aug. 19th. 1940.
- 5. His employers in Listowel speak highly of the subject and state that he is an excellent worker and that his actions leave no doubt of his loyality to the British Empire.
- 6. Subject stated that he had a brother in the Canadian Navy and that he died at his post aboard the H.F.G.S. Fraser. Subject's Nother received a letter of condolation from Ner Rejesty, Queen Elizabeth, also some photographs of the Suneral. Subject also added that there was another of his brothere serving in the Canadian Active Armed Corces.
- 7. Chief Fetty Officer Feterson, stationed in London with the R.C.N.V.A., stated that he had known MONEYL on the West Coast and was acquainted with him. MONEYL can efrom Blucher, Sask., and was well-liked during his term of culistment in the Navy, and that he had perished aboard the B.A.G.S. Fraser. This correlerates the subject's statement that his trother had been in the Navy and die d in service.
