Dear Mrs. Moore:

With reference to your inquiry of the 12th of December, 1943, it is the practice of the Department to initially inform the immediate next-of-kin of a casualty of the Canadian Naval Forces, as in most cases the names and correct mailing addresses of other members of the family are not known. Accordingly, your daughter-in-law, Mrs. Rusha G. Moore, was notified on the 28th of June, 1940.

As Yeoman of Signals Moore was not reported to have been picked up by any of the ships in the vicinity of the sinking of H.M.C.S. "Fraser" and in view of the time that has elapsed since his reported loss, no hope may be given that he is alive or a prisoner of war. Had he been picked up and taken prisoner of war in German hands, it is more than probable that his name would have been forwarded by this time to the Department through official channels or the International Red Cross.

With regard to your inquiry about a Memorial Cross, it is very much regretted that you have not already received one of these Crosses. As your current mailing address was not known at the time that a Cross was forwarded to his wife, a letter was sent to her asking for this information. A reply to this inquiry has not been received, although it may have gone astray. However, a Memorial Cross, which is now in the hands of the engravers, will be forwarded to you in due course as a memento of your personal loss and sacrifice.

Please allow me at this time to express the sincere sympathy of the Department in your bereavement.
