

Further to my letter of the 1st of May, 1945, I am passing on the following particulars regarding the mishap during which your son, Alfred George Shimmin, Leading Stores Assistant, Official Number V-45064, Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve, was killed. This information is now being released for publication.

In the late afternoon of the 11th of April. 1945, while your son's ship, H.M.C.S. "STRATHADAM", a Royal Canadian Naval frigate, was preparing for an encounter with an enemy U-boat, believed to be in the vicinity, a premature explosion occurred in the ship.

Six ratings, including your son, were killed or died later of wounds as a result of the tragedy, while several were injured.

May I again express the sincere sympathy of the Department with you in your bereavement.
