Dear Sir:

With reference to your letter dated 22nd September, 1942, regarding Eric J. Bowman, Able Seaman, R.C.N.V.R., C.N. V.17584, I am directed to inform you that this rating was reported "missing believed killed in action" on the occasion of the loss of H.M.C.S. "Ottawa" as a result of enemy action.

All of the ships which were in company with H.M.C.S. "Ottawa" at the time of the loss have since arrived in port and it is regretted that this rating was not amongst the survivors then landed. Accordingly, no hope can be held out for his survival.

I regret that at this time it is not permissible to inform you of the date of the loss of H.M.C.S. "Ottawa". You will be informed, however, immediately approval has been given for the official release of the date of the loss.
