In accordance with the information supplied, there is one child, a minor, but authority has been obtained to pay amounts distributable to minors, to the widow, or parent, or guardian, or such other person, as the case may be, who has the custody of such minors, so that their shares may be applied for the maintenance, education and benefit of each such minor, respectively. In this instance, the sum of \$38.56 may be paid to you, providing you undertake to use the money accordingly and sign and return, in the meantime, the form of receipt annexed hereto.

If the form, duly signed, reaches us within the next few days, it is anticipated that cheques can be forwarded within a short time thereafter.



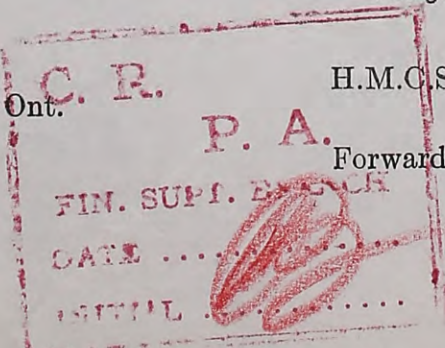
