

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

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

Submitted for the consideration of the Department that the abovenamed rating has applied to transfer from the V/S to the W/T Branch. Previously to being rated Boy Signalman on 15 June, 1926, he was being trained for Boy Telegraphist, though no official notation of this was made in his Service Certificate as at that time there was a shortage in the V/S Branch, and the Signal Officer trained and passed him for Boy Signalman instead.

This rating is recommended for transfer to the W/T Branch, and it is proposed that he join up with Willis and Piuze to train for Ordinary Telegraphist.





So if it wouldn't be bothering you too much would you please find out some information for me please. Again I thank you for your kindness and may I say I'm very glad for you that you were saved, and may God guide you and keep you safe in all you do while this terriable war is on.
