


### TRACK CHART

#### Armament:


Can carry various types of pyrotechnics, flares, explosives and grenades. Vicious fighters if cornered.


**Propulsion:** High economy malt-fuelled single engine.


**Speed:** Largely dependent on whether arriving or departing.






