" A letter recently forwarded to your mother, Mrs Margaret Jones at 5025 Cypress Street, Vancouver, B.C., has been returned to this Branch unclaimed.

It is therefore requested that you send to this Branch any information you may have as to your mother's present whereabouts.

On receipt of the above information we will then be in a position to forward to her the War Service Gratuities in respect of your late brother."

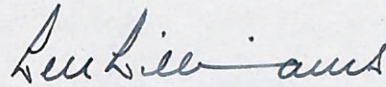
In the latter connection I would refer you to my letter of 9th July last to the Naval Board Secretary, receipt of which was duly acknowledged on 18th July. Copies of both these letters are enclosed for your perusal, together with a copy of the Secretary's letter of 25th July to Miss Jones in connection with the matter.

As you will gather therefrom, it would appear that Miss Jones would probably be entitled to the War Services Gratuity payable in respect of her late brother since she and her brother were the only children of the late Hubert Jones who died in Vancouver in August 1938 and the late Margaret Jones who died in the same city in November 1942. Mrs Jones also had three children by a former marriage, namely, myself and two other sisters, all of whom are living. In the event it should be held that the War Services Gratuity mentioned, being originally payable to Mrs Jones, should now devolve upon her legal beneficiaries

which, by will duly probated in the Supreme Court of British Columbia in 1942, comprise myself, my two sisters and half-sister Miss Jones, please be advised that I and my two sisters are willing and prepared to waive any possible right to or interest in the said Gratuity in favour of Miss Jones.

Should the above information omit any particulars you may require or in any other respect be insufficient for your purposes, I should be pleased to hear from you in due course.

Dear Madam:

Under the provisions of the War Service Grants Act, 1944, and supplementary Orders-in-Council, payment of a war service gratuity has been authorized on behalf of every member of the forces who died on active service.

The regulations provide that a person who was dependent upon the serviceman at the time of his death is entitled to the gratuity. If, however, it is found that the deceased had no dependents, then the gratuity will form part of his service estate.

To be entitled to the gratuity as a dependent of the serviceman, the person applying must either have been eligible for dependents' allowance on his behalf or must have been receiving an assignment of pay from him and have been dependent in whole or in part upon him. The receipt of an assignment of pay alone does not determine entitlement, since the assignment must have been used at least in part for the support of the recipient in order to establish dependency. The fact must also be stressed that where one or more persons received dependents' allowance on behalf of the member of the forces, those persons are solely entitled to the gratuity, although another person may have been receiving an assignment of pay and may have been partly dependent upon him.

As the Service Authorities who are responsible for payment of the gratuity are anxious to settle all entitlements as soon as possible, this letter is being addressed to you as the next-of-kin according to this Department's records of the late Ackland Hubert Jones, Ordinary Seaman, Official Number 3421, R.C.N., with a view to inviting an application for the gratuity either from one who was dependent upon him at the time of his death under the foregoing conditions or, if no dependency existed, from one who is authorized to act on behalf of his estate.

You will appreciate that in all cases the question of dependency must first be settled before payment of the gratuity can be made. For that reason and in order to deal with each case as soon as possible, it is requested that a letter be forwarded addressed to the Secretary, Naval Board, Naval Service Headquarters, Ottawa, indicating whether it is your desire or that of any other person who may qualify as a dependent of the deceased to apply for the gratuity as a dependent or whether payment should be made to the deceased member's service estate.

Your early attention to this request will be greatly appreciated.

If you have already made application for War Service Gratuity it is requested that this letter be disregarded.

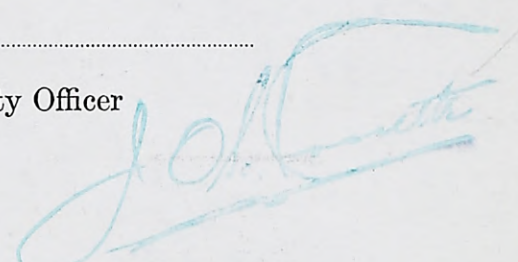

It is with deep regret that I must confirm the telegram sent out by the Minister of National Defence, reporting that your son, Ackland Hubert Jones, Ordinary Seaman. O.N. 3421, R.C.N., was missing, believed killed.

Few details are available, but it is known that H.M.C.S. "MARGAREE" was sunk in collision in the North Atlantic whilst steaming without lights, on convoy duty, and in the submarine zone. 142 Officers and ratings are missing and must be presumed lost at sea.

I am requested to express to you the sincere sympathy of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services and the Chief of the Naval Staff in your bereavement.

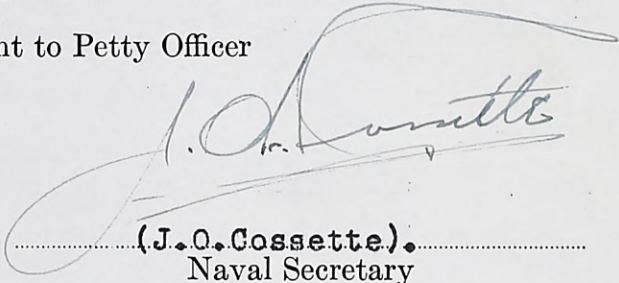
