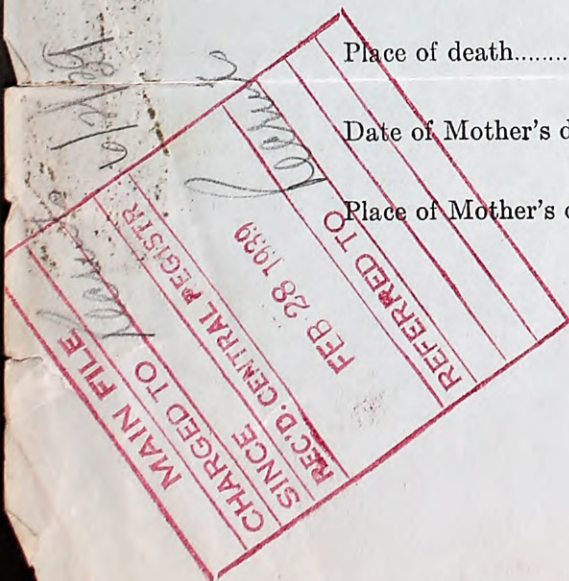

Dear Madam:

It is with deep regret that I must confirm the telegram sent out by the Minister of National Defence, reporting that your son, Alfred Ernest Jones, Boy Seaman, O.N. 3422, R.C.N., was missing, believed killed.

Few details are available, but it is known that H.M.C.S. "MARGAREE" was sunk in collision in the North Atlantic whilst steaming without lights, on convoy duty, and in the submarine zone. 142 Officers and ratings are missing and must be presumed lost at sea.

I am requested to express to you the sincere sympathy of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services and the Chief of the Naval Staff in your bereavement.

Any further information, which is received, will be at once communicated to you.

With reference to your letter of the 27th November, it is much regretted that in Naval Service Headquarters' letter of the 1st November, your son was referred to as Boy Seaman. He was, in fact, rated Ordinary Seaman on the 1st August, 1940.

Reports show that all the survivors of the "FRASER" behaved with courage and devotion to duty at the time that she was sunk, but your son's name was not especially singled out for recognition and, therefore, he was not recommended for a decoration.

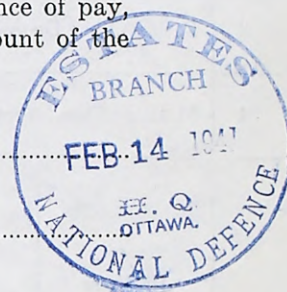

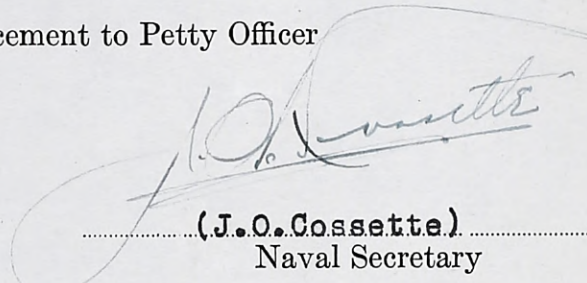
