

SIR,

In consideration of my being enrolled a member of the overseas Division of the Royal Naval Canadian Volunteer Reserve, I undertake and bind myself :—

1. To serve for the period of the War from the date hereof (unless previously discharged) being subject to the provisions of the " Naval Service Act," and of the Regulations made in pursuance thereof, for the government of the Royal Naval Canadian Volunteer Reserve, and to the customs and usages of His Majesty's Naval Service.
2. I recognize my liability to serve ashore or afloat as may be directed by the Department of the Naval Service or the Admiralty, and anywhere the Department or the Admiralty may have need of my services.
