

I am directed to inform you that the Commis-
sioners have ruled in the above noted case as follows:

"Applicant is not entitled to pension as the Commission is
of the opinion that she does not comply with the require-
ments of Section 32(3), which reads as follows:

'A woman who, although not married to the member of
the forces, was living with him in Canada at the
time he became a member of the forces and for a
reasonable time previously thereto, and who, at
such time, was publicly represented by him as his
wife may, in the case of his death and in the dis-
cretion of the Commission, be awarded a pension
equivalent to the pension she would have received
had she been his legal widow, and the Commission
may also award a pension if, in its opinion, an in-
justice would be done by not recognizing a woman as
the wife of a member of the forces although there is
no evidence that she had been publicly represented
by him as his wife. Provided that such woman shall
not be refused a pension for which she would have
been eligible under the provisions hereof if she had
remained unmarried, by reason only of her having
married the member of the forces with whom she had
been living as aforesaid.'

The evidence is not sufficient to establish entitlement
for the child as there is no proof that the child was ac-
knowledged by the deceased.

In the circumstances the Commission is regretfully of the
opinion that no pension can be awarded in this case."


