I would be pleased if you would supply me with the following information.

The above party is a sailor in the Navy at Esquimalt and left High River, Alberta for Esquimalt about January 15, 1940.

He is married to a girl who is under 21 years of age and who is a beneficiary under an estate of which I am acting as solicitor. The executor of this estate has been appointed her guardian and he wishes to obtain information as to the responsibility of the husband for his wife's support.

I believe there is some ruling in the Navy that a man who is married cannot get support for his dependents until he is 22 yrs of age. This man was married about a year and a half before he entered the Navy and he has a wife and two children. It would not seem fair that the government can take him away from his responsibilities at home and not provide for his wife and children. Will you please definitely advise me as to whether or not the wife is entitled to an allowance for herself and for her two children. Would you tell me if it is possible, how it can be enforced if he refuses to have it done voluntarily.

I wish to thank you for any courtesy in this regard.


It is with deep regret that I must confirm the telegram sent out by the Minister of National Defence, reporting that your husband, Lincoln E. Weiser, Stoker II, O.N.21672, R.C.N., was missing, believed killed.

Few details are available, but it is known that H.M.C.S. "MARGAREE" was sunk in collision in the North Atlantic whilst steaming without lights, on convoy duty, and in the submarine zone. 142 Officers and ratings are missing and must be presumed lost at sea.

I am requested to express to you the sincere sympathy of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services and the Chief of the Naval Staff in your bereavement.

Any further information, which is received, will be at once communicated to you.

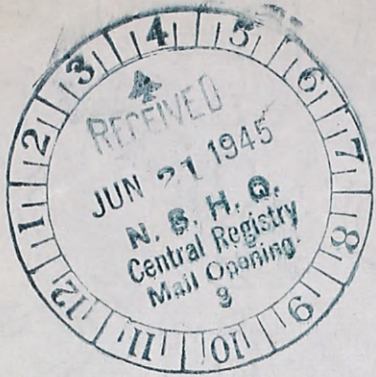
