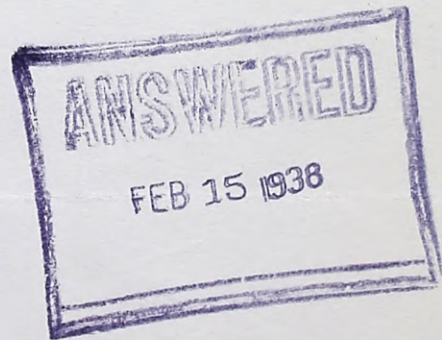




It is with deep regret that I must confirm the telegram sent out by the Minister of National Defence, reporting that your son, Victor S. Wheeler, Ordinary Seaman, O.N. 3268, R.C.N., was missing, believed killed.

Few details are available, but it is known that H.M.C.S. "MARGAREE" was sunk in collision in the North Atlantic whilst steaming without lights, on convoy duty, and in the submarine zone. 142 Officers and ratings are missing and must be presumed lost at sea.

I am requested to express to you the sincere sympathy of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services and the Chief of the Naval Staff in your bereavement.

Any further information, which is received, will be at once communicated to you.

Dear Mr. Wheeler,

Mr. Macdonald has asked me to acknowledge on his behalf your letter of May 6th, asking why you have not received a memorial cross to commemorate the loss of your son, V. S. Wheeler.

I am sorry to have to advise you that the Regulations are such that you are not eligible to receive this Cross. The Regulations state that a Cross will be issued to the widow or the mother of every sailor who laid down his life for his country during the present war, who is survived by either. If both survive, two Crosses will be issued, one to each.

Mr. Macdonald has asked me to express his regrets that it is not possible to meet your wishes in this matter, and to assure you of his deepest sympathy in your bereavement.
