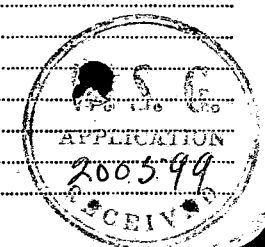

Sir:

I have the honour to request that I be discharged (demobilized) from the Royal Canadian Navy to date 30th, September 1947, in accordance with Naval Service Headquarters' signal 281535 Z of August 1947.

As I was lent to the Royal Canadian Navy from the Royal Navy on July 1940, I should normally be returned to the United Kingdom to be discharged from the Royal Navy.

I am desirous of remaining in Canada after demobilization. I understand the procedure is to apply to Naval Service Headquarters for permission to do this. It is requested that an application be made on my behalf.

I was medically examined and issued with an immigration identification card on August 2nd, 1946 at Halifax, Nova Scotia. I also made an application at that time through the Commanding Officer of H.M.C.S. "Stadacona" to return to Canada.

With reference to your signal 1443/12 concerning the 6 G.M.'s and 3 T.G.M.'s who are proceeding to Halifax on loan from the Royal Navy, I have to inform you that these ratings are sailing today via Quebec, and a signal confirming their departure will be forwarded in a day or so.

Passages were arranged for the 9 ratings by a C.P.R. steamer, which should have sailed yesterday, but late on Monday night, the 15th instant, I was informed that the steamer was not sailing until Saturday, 20th July. It was then too late to prevent several of these ratings arriving in London, and consideration was given to the question of returning them to their Depots pending the departure of the steamer. On the afternoon of the 16th July, another sudden change was made, and the Canadian Pacific Company informed me that the sailing date had been brought forward from July 20th to early on July 18th.

These rearrangements necessitated C.P.O.'s G.F. Clarke, A Harwood, and R.D. Blofield (G.M.) and J. Mason C.P.O. (T.G.M.) remaining in London, and they may submit for consideration small claims for expenses involved.
